



## NEPA DOCUMENTATION STUDIES

### Victory Village Infrastructure Development, Woolpert Inc., Portsmouth, Virginia

Kerr Environmental Services (KES) participated in the preparation of the *Categorical Exclusion* document and secured an *Environmental Certification Form* from the VDOT and FHWA as part of a team that included participation from Woolpert Inc. and the City of Portsmouth, to secure Federal funding assistance for redevelopment of roads and utilities as part of



Portsmouth's Redevelopment Project. KES performed historic resources and protected species database reviews and coordinated with the Virginia Department of Historic Resources (DHR), the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) and the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF) to secure "capstone letters". A wetland assessment of the property was also performed to complete the *Water Quality Permit and Natural Resources Due Diligence Form* (VDOT form EQ-555) as part of the Categorical Exclusion documentation for the project.
