

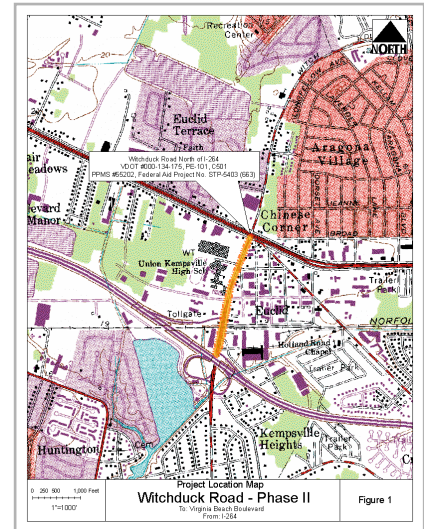


NEPA DOCUMENTATION STUDIES

Witchduck Road Phase II, City of Virginia Beach, Virginia

Kerr Environmental (KES) is preparing the Categorical Exclusion for review by the VDOT and FHWA for widening a 0.5-mile section of Witchduck Road within a commercially developed corridor located in Virginia Beach, Virginia. This project is a *Virginia's First Cities Initiative* project (locality-administered VDOT projects). KES evaluated potential impacts to natural, cultural, recreation, historic, and other resources for several alternatives and compared to the proposed alternative. As part of that effort, KES coordinated with Virginia Department of Historic Resources to alleviate concerns regarding the potential impact to a historically significant school, the first high school for African-

American's in Virginia Beach. In addition, KES performed a Phase I ESA of 32 commercial and institutional properties along the corridor to assess potential contamination areas, attended Citizen Information Meetings, coordinated with local, state, and federal agencies, secured confirmation of a wetland delineation from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and coordinated regarding air and noise investigations.
