## **STORMWATER MANAGEMENT EXPERIENCE**

### **Dry Weather Screening, Survey of Storm Water Outfalls, City of Virginia Beach, Virginia**

Kerr Environmental Services (KES) has performed the dry weather screening as part of the VPDES Phase I compliance monitoring. The program consisted of inspecting a series of 25 stormwater outfalls for signs of illicit discharge. Inspections were conducted following 72 hours of dry weather. If after 72 hours of dry weather there is flow in the channel the outfall was sampled for several water quality parameters to determine if any illicit discharges had reached the outfall. If the channel has received flow the site was sampled a second time within 24 hours. The entire screening was repeated in its entirety 30 days following the first screening.
