

SHORELINE STABILIZATION EXPERIENCE

Columbus Station East, Town Center Condos, Virginia Beach, Virginia

The foundations of six condominium units immediately adjacent to the shoreline of Thalia Creek, as well as several others within the condominium development are failing due to consolidation and erosion. Kerr Environmental Services has completed shoreline stabilization plans, erosion and sediment control plans, and various environmental permitting needs associated with Chesapeake Bay Preservation Area Ordinance and work within Tidal Wetlands. Construction was completed in June 2012.
