## NEPA DOCUMENTATION STUDIES

### Clarke Manor Redevelopment, Chesapeake Community Advisors, Environmental Assessment, Portsmouth, Virginia

Kerr Environmental Services (KES) prepared the *Categorical Exclusion* document and secured an *Environmental Certification Form* from the VDOT and FHWA to secure federal funds from the **Recreational Trail Program**.

The project consists of construction of 26,400 linear feet of a community trail that networks key areas throughout the Town of Cape

Charles as well as provides access to the central park, the historic district, and links to the beach. KES performed database reviews for historic resources and protected species in the area and coordinated with state and federal agencies to obtain “capstone letters”. KES performed a wetland assessment and a hazardous materials database search and site evaluation to complete the *Hazardous Materials Due Diligence Certification Form* (VDOT form EQ-121) and the *Water Quality Permits and Natural Resources Due Diligence Form* (VDOT form EQ-555).
