NEPA DOCUMENTATION STUDIES

Salem Road Princess Anne Road Intersection, City of Virginia Beach, Virginia

Kerr Environmental Services (KES) prepared portions of the *Categorical Exclusion* documentation and secured an *Environmental Certification Form* from VDOT to construct additional lanes at the Salem Road-Princess Anne Road Intersection as required for *Virginia's First Cities Initiative* projects (locally-administered VDOT projects). As part of this project, KES coordinated with the Department



of the Navy regarding the project encroaching on federal lands. KES performed historic resources and protected species database reviews and coordinated with the Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VDHR), the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), and the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (VDGIF) to secure “capstone letters”. A wetland assessment of the property was also performed, in order to complete all components of the *Water Quality Permit and Natural Resources Due Diligence Form* (VDOT form EQ-555) as part of the Categorical Exclusion documentation for the project.
